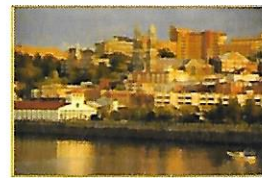
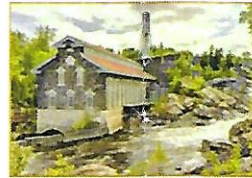

Es wurde 2002 gegründet, indem die Städte Chicoutimi und Jonquières zusammengelegt und kleinere Gerichtsbarkeiten angegliedert wurden. Die Stadt Saguenay bildet ein Gebiet, das einer regionalen Kreisgemeinde entspricht. Die Stadt ist in drei Bezirke unterteilt: Chicoutimi sowie Laterrière und Tremblay. Saguenay liegt in einer Senke im kanadischen Schild, dem Saguenay Graben, der ein etwas gemäßigeres Klima aufweist als die umliegende Region. Dies hat die Landwirtschaft und die Besiedlung durch Menschen gefördert.

Saguenay is a city in the Saguenay-Lac-Saint-Jean region of Quebec, Canada, on the Saguenay River, about 200 kilometres north of Quebec City by overland route. It was formed in 2002 by merging the cities of Chicoutimi and Jonquière and annexing smaller jurisdictions. The city of Saguenay constitutes a territory equivalent to a regional county municipality. The city is divided into three boroughs: Chicoutimi as well as Laterrière and Tremblay township. Saguenay is located in a depression in the Canadian shield called the Saguenay Graben, which has a somewhat more temperate climate than the surrounding region. This has encouraged agriculture and human settlement to take place. The relatively small and concentrated Lac St-Jean area where the city is located can be described as an isolated "oasis" in the middle of the vast remote wilderness of Northern Quebec. Few roads connect with the area from the south and east, and only one road connects from the northwest. No roads go north from the area into the wilderness; the last roads to the north end just a short distance from the city, and still within the Lac St-Jean area.

Deputy Captain Aureliano Mazzella.

Aureliano was born in the Eternal City of Rome and grew up on between the Capital city and the small Island of Ponza in Italy where his family comes from. From a young age he lived by the sea and often taken out fishing on a boat by his grandfather since the age of 10, he was drawn to a career at sea. After high school Aureliano attended the Merchant Navy College "M. Colonna" in Rome, at the age of 13 for 5 years where he began his cadetship, after this time he served on ferries and chemical tankers. He later joined Princess Cruises to complete his final 2 years of his cadetship. Once qualified as Officer of the watch he served on P&O Cruises and Ocean Village working his way through the ranks from junior watch keeper through Chief Officer on Oriana and Arcadia. In 2013 Aureliano joined Cunard Line as Safety Officer on Queen Elizabeth and later Queen Mary 2. In 2015 he has been promoted to the rank of Deputy Captain and appointed to Queen Mary 2. Deputy Captain is the second in command and head of the Deck department. This includes overseeing the overall safety and security of the ship, the Bridge navigation team and the exterior maintenance of the ship. When on his leave Aureliano resides between Oxfordshire, where his fiancée Amy is from, and Ponza which is the largest of the Pontine Islands and the furthest away from the coast, an attractive archipelago off the Italian coast between Rome and Naples renown as excellent fishing ground and for the deep blue colour of the water. His hobbies include fishing with his friends and helping his father in his small wine yard on the island.

Passport holders of the following nationalities must hold a Biometric Passport and ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorisation) which is required by United States Customs and Border Patrol for those guests wishing to enter the United States under the Visa Waiver Programme:

Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Chile, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Malta, Monaco, The Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom.

You can apply for an ESTA by going online to <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov>; there is a charge of \$14 for processing and authorisation (plus standard internet charges apply when using the ship's internet facilities). When you have received confirmation, simply print the confirmation page and place it with your passport. Should you require any assistance, please use the Internet Centre between 3.30pm to 5.00pm or 7.00pm to 9.00pm.

If you are a passport holder of the above nationalities and in possession of a valid US visa, you are not required to be in possession of an ESTA.

Failure to be in possession of a valid ESTA when attending the US immigration inspection upon arrival to New York, can result in the individual being fined \$4300 for violating this requirement by United States Customs and Border Patrol.

What to Wear: Smart Attire.

We ask that you wear smart attire in most of our bars, restaurants, and entertainment venues. Smart trousers with a shirt and jacket for gentlemen; tie is optional. Ladies, blouses and skirts or stylish trousers and dresses are welcome.
