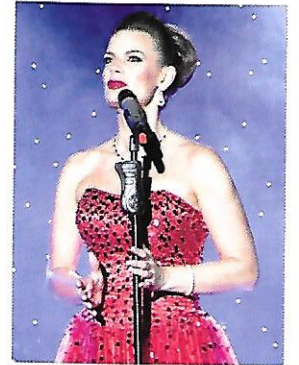

## U.S. immigration and Customs Formalities.

Upon arrival in New York, it is a requirement of United States Customs and Border Protection to inspect **all** guests face to face against their passport, regardless of nationality or whether you are continuing your voyage with us. **(All guests on board are required to attend).** This inspection will be carried out in the Terminal Building ashore, and you are kindly requested to carefully follow the disembarkation instructions that will be delivered to your stateroom.

### Finally Disembarking Guests.

After you have finally disembarked Queen Mary 2, you will collect your luggage from the baggage hall and then proceed through the Immigration Inspection and clear Customs.

### Guests continuing their voyage with us.

All guests are required to attend the Immigration and Customs Inspection. Please be advised that you will NOT be allowed to return to the ship until all guests have disembarked. If you are not intending to go ashore for the day, please proceed to the Terminal when the final announcement is made over the ships public address system. Once you have cleared the inspection, you may proceed to the Embarkation Hall, where there is seating available. You will be advised once you are allowed to re-board Queen Mary 2. For your information there is no need to check-in again.

### What is required for the inspection?

**Passport** - All guests regardless of nationality are required to present a passport.

**Immigration and Customs Forms** - If you are a US or Canadian Citizen, Green Card, ARC Card or have a valid US Visa in your passport then no Immigration forms are required. Please note the US Customs form is no longer required as of 1 February 2018.

**ESTA** (Electronic System for Travel Authorisation) - If you are a passport holder of one of the nationalities listed under the Visa Waiver Programme and do not have a valid US Visa, you should be in possession of an ESTA.

Failure to be in possession of a valid ESTA when attending the US immigration inspection upon arrival to New York can result in the individual being fined \$4300 for violating this requirement.

## What to Wear: Smart Attire.

We ask that you wear smart attire in most of our bars, restaurants, and entertainment venues. Smart trousers with a shirt and jacket for gentlemen; tie is optional. Ladies, blouses and skirts or stylish trousers and dresses are welcome. If you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, feel free to dress more casually in the following venues: Kings Court, Golden Lion, Casino, Carinthia Lounge and G32. Please note non-ripped jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

## Alcohol Policy.

Guests under 18 years of age (21 in US ports and territorial waters) will not be served alcoholic beverages nor are they to consume them on board. Please be aware that proof of age by means of government issued photographic identification, may be requested. Guests under the age of 18 are not permitted in G32.

For guests disembarking in New York on 18 October, please note the deadline of 6.00pm today, 17 October for the following services:

- Making a cash payment. After this deadline, all charges will be settled to the registered credit card. Please be advised that no cash will be refunded to your credit card.
  - Charging cash back and/or foreign exchange to your on board account. Cash for cash foreign exchange facilities/transactions are available until the time of disembarkation on 18 October.
- Guests disembarking and settling their accounts in cash will need to visit the Purser's Office anytime before disembarking to finalise their account. Please note that failure to settle your account will result in delays to your disembarkation.
